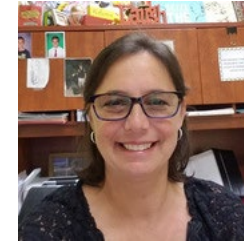

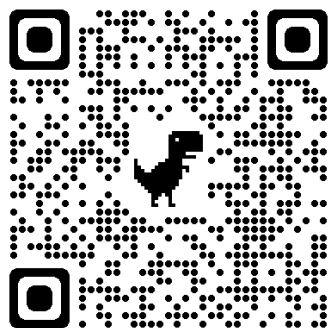


- Mi nombre es Sra. Mederos y tengo el honor y el placer de ser su asesora de CAP.

Complete the FAFSA® Form

Mandatory

- What is FAFSA..... It is the Free Application for Student Aid form that a Student is required to complete to attend post-secondary Education. Every Student must complete the FAFSA. The application opening date has not been released as of yet. The student will receive an email once I have that date.

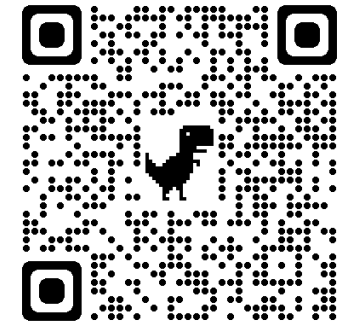

- Every student MUST create a SCOIR account. It is a mandatory requirement for SENIORS.
- Students can access their accounts through Clever using their student portal login.
- SCOIR is used for:
 - Researching colleges and universities
 - Marking schools as applying, applied, and/or enrolling
 - All schools listed under applied should have an outcome listed on SCOIR.
 - Linking CommonApp to SCOIR using CommonApp ID is just for information, information is not shared between both SCOIR and CommonAPP
 - Requesting Teacher Recommendations (see next slides)
 - Scheduling appointments with Ms. Mederos
 - Obtain fee waivers for applications and enrollment deposit
- SENIORS WILL NOT BE CLEARED FOR GRADUATION UNTIL THEY SHARE THEIR OUTCOMES AND/OR MARK A SCHOOL AS ENROLLING.

Steps to request a letter of recommendation in SCOIR

Go to My Colleges in SCOIR

Click on Application Documents

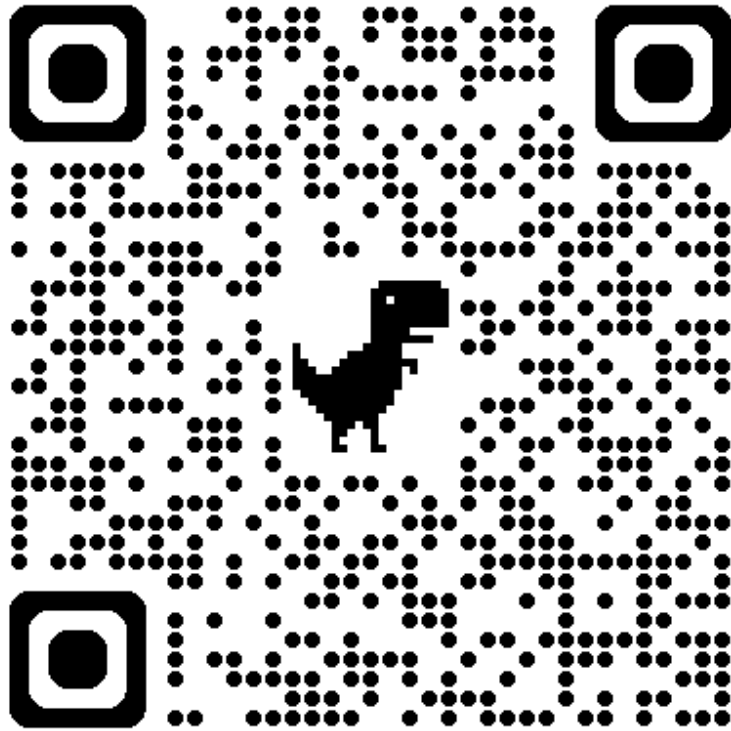
Click on New Request

Complete a Brag Sheet (see the next slide)

*** I always suggest letting the Teacher/Counselor know in person you will or have requested a letter from them in SCOIR.
Additionally, please send requests to Ms. Mederos 4 weeks in advance.
Check with your Teacher choice to consider their turnaround time.

Letters of Recommendation (brag sheet)



Go to SCOIR and request a letter of recommendation from Ms. Mederos as Counselor or from a Teacher of your choice.

Letters will ONLY be sent through SCOIR.

High school Transcripts

What is a Transcript?

- Your high school transcript is a complete report of your academic record in high school.
- Transcripts give college/university offices a picture of who you are as a student as they review your academic record.
- Most transcripts include:
 - Your name, address, and date of birth
 - The name of your school
 - The courses you've taken and when you took them
 - Your final grades for each course you completed.
 - The weight of each grade (grades in higher-level courses like AP or Honors are often worth more than the same grade in a standard course)
 - The number of credits you earned for each course
 - Your cumulative GPA
 - Community Service Hours Completed

Grad Track Report Vs. Official Transcript

GradTrack Report

- GradTrack report is a record that serves as an unofficial transcript. It can be accessed by the student through the student portal.
- It can be used for self-reported transcripts

Official Transcript

- The official transcript must be requested and ordered. It has more detailed information than the GradTrack report.
- This is the report that will be reviewed by the college/university admissions office.



3 Types of Official Transcripts



The only way to send your transcript to a College/University/Trade School is through SCOIR if the school is listed in the APPLIED column! The Registrar's office will not send your transcript if it is not! See Ms. Mederos with questions

Initial Transcript

- Is an official transcript sent to schools that the student enters into the Applied column in SCOIR from August to February by Ms. Mederos

Mid-Year Transcript

- Is an official transcript sent to schools that the student enters into the Applied column in SCOIR and includes the updated GPA that will be used for student class percentile and includes Semester 1 grades. This is done around February 10th by Ms. Mederos

Final Transcript

- This is the final transcript sent to the school the student has listed as enrolled in SCOIR. Please note that this transcript is sent by the Registrar on or about June 25th when the District processes the graduation file.
