It is very important that all members attend all practices and all special events. Extra practices and events will be added to the calendar as the year progresses. If you have any questions, comments or concerns do not hesitate to contact us. All contact information is attached to this packet under contact information.

Coral Park Cheerleading Team

We are here to build a Spirit Cheerleading team. A School Spirit Cheerleading Team requires a high level of commitment from not only the child but also the parents. We will be building two teams depending on the athlete's experience, skill level, attitude, and ability to increase squad morale.

The first commitment has to do with time and participation. All Cheerleaders who make the team are expected to be at twice a week practice for the entire year as well as participate in pep rallies, cheer at games and attend several school events. Extra practices may also be added when performances are coming up and cheerleaders are expected to make this team a priority and attend. Our practices are set to be on **Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:00-5:00pm (Sometimes Fridays)**. During the summer months, we will be having **MANDATORY** camps on specific days which will be released later in which we will be building their skills. We ask for your full cooperation in attending these camps as this is our only time in the summer that we are able to train the athletes to be ready for their first game and pep rally which usually takes place as soon as school starts. This means the teams must be fully knowledgeable in cheers, sideline dances, stunts and have a pep rally routine choreographed by the time that school starts. If for any reason you have plans that do not allow for your child to make it to camp, you and your child must understand that they will not be able to participate in the first pep rally routine. They will be doing sideline dances at the first pep rally and be with the cheer team. However, they will not actually be choreographed in the routine as they missed hours of training that need to be made up and coaches cannot hold spots for the athletes when choreographing. However, there are many pep rallies in one year so they will be okay to participate in the next ones as long as they are at their practices.

The second commitment has to do with expenses, the cheerleading team does have certain expenses associated with it. Every child receives two sets of practice clothes with a practice bow, a complete uniform, a warm-up jacket, game day jersey, 2 game day bows, Pom Poms, and attends three Cheer Camps: Skill Progression Intense Cheer Camp, Skill Building Football/Pep Rally Camp and Pep Rally/Basketball Camp. If your child makes the team, you are responsible for completing the payment of these expenses even if they quit the team. There are fundraising opportunities available at various times of the year, but it is up to you and your child to become involved and participate in any fundraising opportunity. Our performance season will begin as soon as school starts as we kick off the first week of school with our First Pep Rally. We will then be participating in football/basketball/flag football games, school pep rallies throughout the year, games, New Student Orientation, Open House, and other school events. It is very important to understand that as Coral Park Cheerleaders we represent the school at all times and are there to be the "face" of school spirit as well as help at any school events that may pop up. During this time of the year, if we feel that we need it, we will be scheduling extra practices at the school. We try our best to plan ahead for school events and pep rallies however, the school may ask us to be part of events the week of, and we need to make it work.

IN ORDER TO TRYOUT/STAY ON THE CHEERLEADING SQUAD YOU MUST MEET AND KEEP ALL THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- You must have a 2.0 grade point average.
- School attendance follows the 10:20 rule (You can't have reached 10 unexcused absences & 20 tardies)

If student reaches or passes over the 10:20 rule sponsor/coach/administration has the right to put the cheerleader on probation or remove from them from the team. Once cheerleader has reached the 10:20 rule they will stay on probation until the remainder of the school year.

- Must have a completed physical and cleared from the Athletics Office
- Must have school insurance paid NO ONE MAY TRYOUT WITHOUT A COMPLETED PHYSICAL AND PROOF (RECEIPT) OF PURCHASED SCHOOL INSURANCE.
- Summer insurance will be MANDATORY and so will summer practice.
- Satisfactory completion of this packet
- Parent/Guardian must sign every page: Commitment from parents and students is mandatory.
- Application packet is due Day 1 of clinics, you will not be able to participate in the tryout process without this packet completed and turned in.

CORAL PARK SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL CHEERLEADERS RULES, REGULATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

A Coral Park Cheerleader represents Coral Park Senior High and is expected to uphold only the highest standards of character and conduct. Everything you do as a cheerleader reflects on the entire squad. For this reason, cheerleaders must always set a good example and be careful to act in a courteous and respectful manner at all times. Cheerleaders are expected to be conscious of the fact that they are constantly on display, representing Coral Park even when they are not wearing their uniform.

- A Coral Park cheerleader must obey all school rules, always follow the school dress code, and promote school spirit.
- A Coral Park cheerleader must have nails kept short to prevent accidents.
- A Coral Park cheerleader must participate in ALL activities undertaken by the squad. These activities include, but are not limited to fundraising, tumbling, practices, cheer camp, games, local and away performances. All activities will be up to the sponsor's own discretion.
- ♥ A Coral Park cheerleader may not be a member of any other team sport or dance team, due to the rigorous schedule. Any employment must not interfere with any cheerleading event. If you need to miss practice, games, or event due to work, you WILL BE DISMISSED.
- ♥ A Coral Park cheerleader must make practices, games, competitions, and all other cheer associated events a priority.
- A Coral Park cheerleader must always exhibit independent and responsible behavior. You must complete any required paperwork on time, be kept abreast of all upcoming events and take responsibility for YOUR sport.
- A Coral Park cheerleader must be in school at least half a day in order to participate in any event that day including practice.
- A Coral Park cheerleader must arrive on time to school which is before 7:20am. If there is an event where the cheerleader is in uniform and they arrive late and receive a tardy pass, you cannot cheer with the squad at that event.
- If you are absent from school the day of the event, you cannot cheer with the team. ATTENDANCE IS VERY IMPORTANT AND CLOSELY MONITORED.
- ♦ A Coral Park cheerleader must obey the 10:20 school attendance rule (You can't have reached 10 unexcused absences & 20 tardies). IF student reaches or passes over the 10:20 rule sponsor/coach/administration has the right to put the cheerleader on probation or remove from them from the team. Once cheerleader has reached the 10:20 rule they will stay on probation until the remainder of the school year.
- ♥ A Coral Park cheerleader must always follow instructions and respect the sponsors, coaches, faculty, and members of the cheerleading squad. Behavior problems, gossip, and lying affecting the team or any of our squad members will NOT be tolerated. This includes talk that disrespects the team and/or team member.
- Coral Park cheerleaders are not permitted to be members of any fan/groups or make comments on any form of social media (Facebook, Twitter, Snap chat, Instagram, etc.) that is derogatory to any student or staff member. This type of negative behavior will NOT be tolerated. If in doubt, don't post.
- Have access and check "whatsapp" regularly. This is our main means of communication.
- A Coral Park cheerleader must always remain classy and humble.
- ♥ A Coral Park cheerleader must not show any form of affection while in uniform. No public display of affection.
- A Coral Park cheerleader must notify the **SPONSOR/COACH** of any excused absence or late arrival.
- The cheer sponsors and/or Coral Park administration have the right to suspend or remove any cheerleader from the squad at his/her own discretion.
- The Coral Park cheerleader must be able to execute all cheers and performance with perfection. In the event that a cheerleader is not performing up to expectations, the sponsors may suspend or remove the cheerleader at their own discretion.
- A Coral Park cheerleader may only miss 1 football game per season and 1 basketball game per season. Missing more than one game will result in immediate dismissal from squad.
- A Coral Park cheerleader may NOT miss any pep rally practice. If they do, they will not be able to perform in the pep rally with the team.

CORAL PARK SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL CHEERLEADERS RULES, REGULATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES CONTINUED

- If you are injured, you must still attend practices and events. You will be required to sit with the coach and lend support to our team.
- If you are physically injured, a doctor's note is required in order for you to return to practice.
- The sponsors will take any disciplinary action for misconduct of cheerleaders.
- If you are absent from practice, you must submit a note from your doctor.
- All members of the squad that are not performance ready will be removed from the routine until the sponsors feel that they are performance ready.
- Cheerleading is a year-round commitment.
- On performance days cheerleaders are expected to practice during lunch.
- If you have previously quit or have been removed from the Coral Park cheerleading squad, you are not eligible to tryout again.
- You must attend all cheer monthly meetings.
- In order to earn a cord for graduation you must cheer for 2 years.

Reasons for suspension/probation from the squad:

When a cheerleader is placed on probation or suspension, they are required to attend all practices and events. However, cheerleaders on probation/suspension will not be permitted to participate in any cheer related functions and events. If you are on probation or suspension, you are NOT permitted to wear your uniform. The sponsors will determine the length of probation/suspension.

- In order to monitor improvement while on probation, cheerleaders will be required to turn in a weekly progress report if the suspension is for grades. It is the cheerleader's responsibility to submit the report to the sponsors at the end of each day. Failure to do so will result in dismissal from the squad.
- A lack of improvement in grades, conduct, effort of falling below a 2.0 GPA during probationary period will result in immediate dismissal from the squad.
- Failure to follow 10:20 school attendance rule (You can't reach 10 unexcused absences & 20 tardies). If student reaches or passes over the 10:20 rule sponsor/coach/administration has the right to put the cheerleader on probation or remove from them from the team. Once cheerleader has reached the 10:20 rule they will stay on probation until the remainder of the school year.
- Cheerleaders will only be allowed ONE probationary period per school year. If issues continue to arise OR do not improve within the two-week probationary period, the cheerleader will be immediately dismissed from the team and will be unable to tryout again.

IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM THE SQUAD FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

- Failure to meet the requirements of the academic/conduct/performance probation or falling below a 2.0 GPA.
- ♥ Stealing or fighting
- S.C.S.I. or outdoor suspension
- Disorderly conduct
- Smoking or use of controlled substance
- Receiving more than two detentions
- Failure to follow instructions or disrespect of the sponsor, coach or any member of the team
- Behavioral problems, gossiping or lying affecting the morale of the team
- Any other inappropriate behavior as determined by the sponsor or school administration
- Violation of attached "social media" contract will result in immediate removal from squad

CHEERLEADERS WILL RECEIVE DEMERITS FOR THE FOLLOWING:

Three Strike Rule to Receive 1 Demerit Three demerits=Two-week suspension Six demerits=Dismissal from Squad

- ✓ Unexcused (without prior notification to sponsor) absence from fundraising activity
- ✓ Unexcused (without prior notification to sponsor) absence from school activity/event
- \checkmark Unexcused (without prior notification to sponsor) absence from practice
- Unexcused (without prior notification to sponsor)) tardy from any practice and/or event
- ✓ Using profanity
- ✓ Failure to wear proper uniform at any time. Uniform must be clean. Shoes must be bright white. Bow must be worn.
- ✓ Violation of the social media contract
- ✓ Use of cellular phones during practice and/or events.
- You must report any demerits, detentions and any disciplinary/academic problems at school or practice to the sponsors. Failure to due so, may result in immediate dismissal from the squad.

- Purchase all attire and accessories necessary
- Be responsible to provide transportation for driving to and picking up your child from all events and activities
- BE ON TIME TO PICK UP YOUR CHILD FROM ALL GAMES AND EVENTS.

CHEERLEADER SOCIAL MEDIA CONTRACT & EXPECTATIONS

Miami Coral Park cheerleaders are representatives of the school and community. At all times Rams cheerleaders must exercise good judgment in their use of social media websites, and to conduct these activities in a *responsible* and *respectful* manner. (Examples of social media websites include, but are not limited to Instagram, Snapchat, Twitter, Facebook and Tik Tok.)

It is impermissible for a Miami Coral Park cheerleader to post information, photos, or other representations of sexual content, inappropriate behavior (e.g., drug or alcohol use), inappropriate language, or items that could be interpreted as demeaning or provocative. This includes, but not limited to, when wearing any RAMS and/or Miami Coral Park Senior High School uniform.

It is **not** permissible to comment on injuries, any decision made by the coach, or team matters that could reasonably be expected to be confidential to team members.

Miami Coral Park cheerleading program will not tolerate disrespectful comments and behavior online, such as:

- ✓ Derogatory language or remarks that may harm teammates, coaches, teachers, other student athletes, or school representatives of Miami Coral Park Senior High or any other schools.
- ✓ Incriminating photos or statements depicting violence, hazing, sexual harassment, full or partial nudity, inappropriate gestures, vandalism, underage drinking, selling/possessing/using controlled substances, or any other inappropriate behavior (including the use of profanity).
- ✓ Creating a danger to the safety of another person or making a credible threat of serious physical or emotional injury to another person.
- ✓ Never involve yourself with alcohol or any other controlled substance. Posting pictures, retweeting or "liking" a post where this behavior is going on also indicates your approval and will be cause for dismissal.

Miami Coral Park cheerleaders are required to follow all respective social media website rules.

Best Practices and Reminders

Think twice before you post. If you wouldn't want your coach, parents, or future employer to see your post, don't post it. Once it's posted, it is <u>permanent.</u>

Be respectful and positive. Never post anything negative about a coach or fellow team member.

Remember, many different audiences view your posts including fans, alumni, kids, local authorities, parents, faculty, etc.

The internet is permanent. Even if you delete something, it's still out there somewhere. Be in the right state of mind when you make a post. The public will see your social media websites. Potential employers often use these social media websites to screen candidates. Use the privacy/security settings made available on these sites.

Posting any information, photos, or content—on or off school campus—that includes sexual material, inappropriate behavior (such as drug or alcohol use), offensive language, or anything deemed demeaning or provocative while wearing a RAMS Cheerleading uniform or a Miami Coral Park Senior High School uniform will result in demerits.

Violation of the Miami Coral Park Cheerleader Social Media Policy will result in disciplinary action – including temporary or permanent suspension from the team – as determined by coach, principal, and/or activities director.

Cheerleaders will receive Demerits: Social Media Demerit Will Be a Three Strike Rule Receive 1st Demerit=Two-week suspension Receive 2nd Demerit=Four-week suspension Receive 3rd Demerit = Dismissal from Squad Keep in mind that every post has a different consequence.

As representatives of our school and programs you are held to a higher standard. Represent your campus with pride and class!!
